

Announcement by the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center regarding the sanctions against exam fraud and violators of exam regulations

In accordance with the announcement of regulations for test candidates by the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center in 2015, and to ensure the orderly transparent conduct of Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center exams, the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center has thus determined the following sanctions against exam fraud and violators of exam regulations.

Authorized in accordance with Article 9 (9) and Article 18, paragraph 2 of the Chulalongkorn University 2015 Statute for the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center, the following announcement has been duly approved by the 4th meeting 2015 of the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center Executive Board on November 12th, 2015.

[According to this announcement] Acts of fraud or violations of the regulations for test candidates are defined here as follows:

1. Bringing textbooks, notebooks, books, written notes, any other documents, watches, handbags, briefcases, audio recorders, cameras, computing devices, equipment which can be used for calculation, communication equipment such as cellular phones or communication radios into the examination room.
2. Copying the exam paper and/or the questions.
3. Taking the exam paper or the answer sheet outside of the examination room.
4. Writing notes, numbers, making drawings or any other markings on the answer sheet.
5. Writing text, markings or symbols of any kind on the ID card or passport, or on the body of an exam candidate, or on anything else that the candidate has brought into the examination room.
6. Taking an exam for another person.
7. Sitting in the wrong seat after the examination has started.
8. Writing anything on the answer sheet or the exam paper after the invigilator has announced the end of the exam.
9. Leaving the examination room before the end of the exam without the permission of an invigilator.
10. Other instances are left to the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Academic Testing Center.

Candidates who commit an act of fraud or violate the exam regulations have to cease writing immediately and are taken to the office of the Test Center Director. They have to sign a statement admitting their wrongdoing and have to remain in the office until the exam is over. Their test paper for the respective subject will not be marked.

Those who have committed an act of fraud or violated the exam regulations will be banned from taking any exams at the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center for a period of two years.
