



## **Prince of Songkla University Announcement**

### **Subject: Measures and monitoring of the coronavirus (2019-nCoV) epidemic outbreak**

Due to the ongoing outbreak of the coronavirus disease (2019-nCoV) originated in the People's Republic of China and spread in many countries, in order to prevent the spread of the disease among staff and students of Prince of Songkla University (PSU), the university deems appropriate to proceed as follows:

1. All PSU students and staff who have traveled or will be traveling in and out of Thailand from January 2020 onwards, if displaying fever or abnormal respiratory symptoms, must see a doctor at a nearby hospital immediately.

2. Students and staff, especially of Chinese nationality, who have traveled to the People's Republic of China during January 2020 and have not yet returned to Thailand, should stay in China for at least 2 weeks, as per the announcement of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation on coronavirus (2019-nCoV) outbreak surveillance and measures on 25 January 2020. However, those who need to return to Thailand must notify the PSU's International Affairs Office about the return trip schedule at least 3 days in advance via email to [psu-international@psu.ac.th](mailto:psu-international@psu.ac.th), in order to help prevent disease outbreaks. The university will gather information and coordinate with the disease screening unit of the hospital responsible for each campus and various related departments.

Please kindly be informed and practice accordingly. Attached to this announcement are the above-mentioned statement of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (subject: Measures and surveillance of the outbreak of coronavirus (2019-nCoV)), and the message of Songklanagarind Hospital, Faculty of Medicine (subject: Information for prevention of respiratory infections), both in Thai and in Chinese language.
