The 2019 PSU-Faculty of Medicine International Student Graduate Scholarships
(PSU-Med ISG Scholarships)
For Master's & Ph.D. studies

Faculty of Medicine, Prince of Songkla University (PSU) realizes that a graduate program is very important foundations for knowledge creation and high quality research publication. Graduate program is also a key for international collaboration and academic internationalization. In order to support, strengthen and internationalize the graduate programs, Faculty of Medicine, Prince of Songkla University is proud to announce the 2019 PSU-Faculty of Medicine International Student Graduate Scholarships (PSU-Med ISG Scholarships) for excellent international students to study in the graduate programs at Faculty of Medicine.

1. Number of Master's/ Ph.D. Degree Scholarships:

Total 4 scholarships, one per program

Programs offered:

- Biomedical Sciences
- Biomedical Engineering
- Epidemiology
- Health Science

2. Duration of Scholarships:

Master's Degree: 2 Years

Doctoral Degree: 3 Years

3. Scholarship value:

- 3.1 The monthly allowance (currently 10,000 Baht, approx. 300 US\$) covers housing and living expenses.
- 3.2 Tuition fee
- 3.3 A travel expense to and from home country at the beginning and the end of the scholarship term respectively (not more than 15,000 Baht, approx. 450 US\$)
- 3.4 Coverage of health and accident insurance during the period of scholarship in Thailand (90 US\$)

4. Application Requirements:

- 4.1 International students with good academic record and research experience
- 4.2 Eligibility is restricted to new graduate student who are expecting to begin his/her studies at Prince of Songkla University in semester 1/2019 (August 2019).
- 4.3 The applicant must hold a Bachelor (for Master's) or Master's degree (for Ph.D.). The subject in which the previous degree was obtained must match and fulfill the requirements of the program's curriculum.
- 4.4 The applicant must not be a recipient of another scholarship that covers living expense during the same period.

- 4.5 The applicant must pass an officially recognized English language examination as below
- TOEFL Paper Based score of 550, or
Computer Based score of 213, or
Internet Based score of 79, or
 - IELTS Score of 6.0
- 4.6 The applicant can choose only one program to apply for.

5. Terms and Conditions:

- 5.1 The scholar must be a full time student with Non-immigrant "ED" visa (Study Permit). The scholar entering Thailand on a tourist visa cannot enroll and may have his/her scholarship cancelled.
- 5.2 The scholar must study and perform the research thesis with an endeavor.
- 5.3 The scholar must report the progress of his/her study to the Faculty of Medicine every 6 months.
- 5.4 The scholar must pass the proposal examination in a second semester for the master's degree and in a third semester for the Ph.D. degree.
- 5.5 To fulfill the scholarship requirements, the scholar must publish his/her dissertation in reputable, peer-reviewed international journal(s) indexed in Web of Science (with ISI impact factor) at least 1 publication and must follow the graduate requirements of each graduate program.
- 5.6 Once an applicant has been accepted for a particular program of study, the scholar is expected to complete that program complete the study within the given time frame and cannot change to a different program of study.
- 5.7 If the scholar has no progress on his/her study or thesis without proper reasons, the committee of each graduate program have to inform to the Faculty of Medicine to terminate a scholarship.
- 5.8 Other terms apply as established by the Faculty of Medicine.

6. Required Documents:

- 6.1 A copy of an English proficiency certificate (valid within 2 years) with a minimum score as follows:
- TOEFL Paper Based score of 550, or
Computer Based score of 213, or
Internet Based score of 79, or
 - IELTS Score of 6.0
- 6.2 Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 6.3 A certified copy of transcript of records for bachelor's/master's degree study with grades and grade point average in English
- 6.4 Statement of purpose (about 800 words)
- 6.5 First page of published publications
- 6.6 Research description/plan
- 6.7 A copy of the mail passport page
- 6.8 A medical certificate (in English)

Remark: The graduate programs of the Faculty of Medicine reserve the right to reject an application if the required documents are not complete.

7. How to apply:

Applications must submit the application online at <https://grad.psu.ac.th/en/prospective-students/admission.html>. The required documents (9 items) must be uploaded via the PSU Graduate School website for the committee to review and consider granting a scholarship. The applicant must choose "Others" for Source of Funding and fill "Apply for PSU-Faculty of Medicine International Student Scholarships (PSU-Med ISG Scholarships)".


8. Method of selection:
