Announcement of Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University

Re: Application for Research Grant for Thesis in the Fiscal Year 2019 and Cancellation on the Announcement of Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University issued on January 21, 2019

According to the Graduate School has already announced the Announcement of Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University issued on January 21, 2019.

To obviously interpret in item no. 3.1.5, the Graduate School would like cancel the Announcement of Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University issued on January 21, 2019 and re-issue this announcement to implement onwards as follows:

**1. Funding Amount:**

| Category of research  | Maximum amount of funding* (Baht) |

\*Remark: Funding amount may be lower than the maximum amount shown in the table, depending on the allocated budget and numbers of applicants.

**2. Applicant Qualification:**

Current graduate students whose thesis proposal is approved within March 31, 2019, are eligible for thesis grant.

**3. Terms:**

3.1 Applicants who receive scholarships or research funds supporting research activities in their thesis are not eligible to this grant. Examples of such scholarships and funds are:

3.1.1. Those with the Office of the Higher Education Commission (The program for development of faculties and personel for higher education institutes in special development areas: Southern Border Provinces)

3.1.2 Those with Graduate School's thesis funding in the past

3.1.3 Those receiving Graduate School's thesis funding in the past and the funding was terminated with any causes.

3.1.4 Those receiving Graduate School's research funding for community problem solving

3.1.5 Those with other fundings providing financial supports for research activities in thesis except those with fundings from the internal and external sources of the university which duration of funding have ended before applying for this grant, is eligible to this grant.

3.2 Graduate students who were retired in the past for any causes and re-applied to the study program are not eligible for the grant.

3.3 The fund will be given to the students in the approved amount after the signing of contract for thesis grant.

3.4 If it is found that the information given in the application form or that reported in the computerized application system is not true, Graduate School reserves the right to suspend granting.

3.5 Applicant needs to revise document as requested by Graduate School in the specified time period such as the request for correcting amount of grant, details of various expenses etc. Otherwise Graduate School will disqualify the application.
