Announcement of the Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University

Re: Criteria for Publications of Research to Fulfill the Requirement for Graduation (No. 2)

The Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University (PSU) has a policy requiring graduate students to publish research papers related to their thesis in journals indexed in national and international databases approved by the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC) or those journals with peer review process and committee and those with the quality approved by Board of Faculty. Published or disseminated outputs from theses or minor theses or from parts of theses or minor theses fulfilling the graduation requirements in accordance with the announcement, regulations or specifications issued by the OHEC and PSU shall satisfy the following requirements

1. Research outputs must be original articles, but not review articles written from the analysis, summarization or review of related research works no matter that the articles cite outputs from theses/minor theses or not.

2. Published original articles must be composed of an introduction (background, rationale of the study, research objectives, methodology, summary and discussion, and reference subjected to the requirement of journals.

For programs with higher requirements on numbers of publications than those specified in the announcement, regulations or requirements issued by the OHEC and PSU, the requirements for publications beyond those required by the OHEC and PSU shall be determined by Board of the Program.

This announcement applies to all currently registered students from now on.
